Truman VA provides a full continuum of care in both inpatient and outpatient settings and is committed to excellent patient care, education and research. The facility provides comprehensive care including primary care, medical and surgical specialty care, behavioral health, physical rehabilitation, and pharmacy services. Also, Truman VA is a referral center for heart care services including open heart surgery. The facility offers Home Based Primary Care, Seamless Transition Clinic for OEF/OIF/OND Veterans, Addictions Treatment Program, Suicide Awareness and Prevention, Support for Homeless Veterans, Tele-Health Services, Visual Impairment Services Team, and Women Veterans Program.

Increasing Access to Rural Veterans:

Truman VA maintains eight community based outpatient clinics located at Jefferson City, Osage Beach, Kirksville, Marshfield, Mexico, Sedalia, Saint James, and Waynesville.

Educating Future Health Care Providers

Truman VA maintains strong affiliations with the University of Missouri's School of Medicine, the Sinclair School of Nursing, the School of Health Professions and other health related programs and provides training opportunities for approximately 900 students each year.
